1. Identify areas where you’re furthest from the norm.

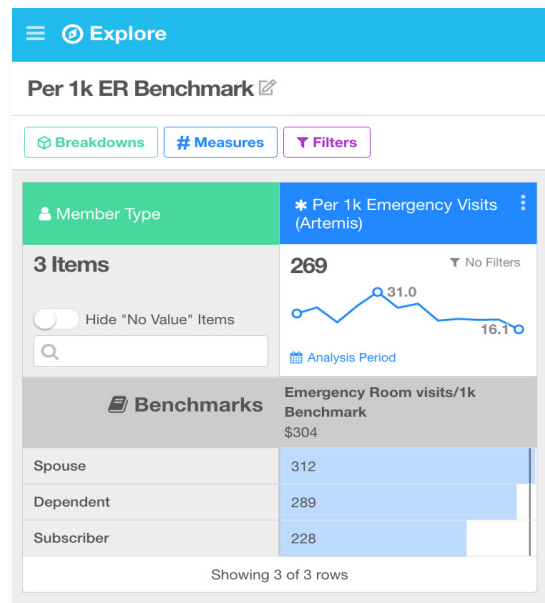
Analyze your population against the benchmarking data to see where your trend-drivers stack up.
